

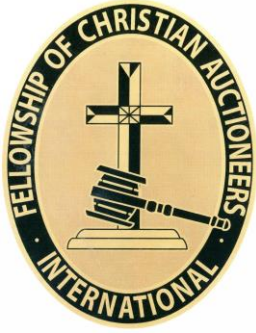

Outline of the duties of a State chaplain

1. It is recommended that the chaplain join their State Auctioneers Assoc.
2. Make sure that a booth is set up at the convention representing the FCAI and working the booth. Assistance is welcomed with this task. You can recruit help as needed from your members.
3. Be willing to serve in the following areas of their State:
 - a. Be willing to maintain a phone number and email address so auctioneers may readily contact them with prayer requests or needs about themselves or others. Then post those needs on the FCAI Website and email the current communications person that emails all the membership.
 - b. Actively recruit other auctioneers who are qualified and would serve as associate chaplains in other areas of their State if needed.
 - c. Be willing to travel a reasonable distance to meet with an auctioneer in need (if their schedule will permit it and not interfere with an auction) if it be sickness, loss of a loved one, etc.
 - d. Be willing to coordinate a prayer breakfast or other event, either at the end or sometime during, their state convention to promote FCAI, have fellowship with Christian auctioneers, witness, have a devotional, maybe some entertainment for their state members.
 - e. Encourage other members to furnish items to bring to their State Associations Fun Auction or to the Prayer Breakfast or/and other FCAI events to sell and designate the funds for the FCAI or even ask for a love offering. Then send a portion of those funds to the current Treasurer for FCAI. (These are tax-deductible contributions and a tax-deductible contribution record will be sent to the donator). This will assist us to fund the Bibles sent in honor of someone who died, gifts to the soldiers of auctioneers who have children serving in the military who are deployed, give-a-ways we give out at NAA Booth, the NAA Booth, and other expenses such as postage stamps, etc.
4. The chaplain should also be looking for good things that has taken place with the auctioneers and their families. We want to share the praises of our members. We have no idea how this may help others that may be down at that point that needed that uplift. It is not required to be in a formal church setting to find the Lord or to see Him work amongst His people. We need to be in a condition to react on a second's notice. Remember it is not us that is handling the situation, it is Him working through us. It is not always what we say or do. It is the results. We are just planting the seed.



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5. We are a mission minded organization that is continually looking to help where help is needed. Several of our State Associations hold benefit auctions where we participate and share with the donations and proceeds. Donations are made through our organization to help on the local, state, and national levels. Your help and ideas will help us achieve this goal. We welcome any ideas. Send them to me or to Alvin so they can be brought before the Board for consideration.
6. As the president of the FCAI, I am available to you with one text, email, or phone call away. I am willing to assist you at any time where I can. I know there may be situations you may be faced with as a chaplain that may be hard to deal with and we will work through it together. I would rather you handle the situation with my assistance.
7. I would like for our chaplains to write a short article at least twice a year so you can share as to how things are going in your ministry in your state. Send them straight to Alvin at akaddatz@yahoo.com. His wonderful staff has been assisting us in getting our information out to our members for a long time. By the way, they do a great job.
8. Immediately inform the President or Alvin Kaddatz of any emergency with an auctioneer so they may contact them personally either by email or phone and let them know we are praying or ask if there is anything we can do beyond that.
9. Remember one thing. You are not out there by yourself. You are representing a great organization with some great past and present leaders that are right by your side seeking the same goal for all people to find Christ in their lives and to be able to continue their walk with Christ.
10. If at all possible attend NAA Conference and Show and represent their state at FCAI.

I want to thank each one of you for serving as chaplains and I want you all to know that prayers are going up all over the world for you on a daily basis. "We can do all things through Christ".
